NEW BOOKS – JANUARY 2021

The Gentle Art of Swedish Death Cleaning: How to Free Yourself and Your Family from a Lifetime of Clutter – Margareta Magnusson. Here's the book to help you with that New Year's resolution to declutter your home.

Land of Love and Drowning – Tiphanie Yanique. Follows three generations of a Virgin Islands family through the changes of the twentieth century beginning in 1904 when two sisters survive a shipwreck.

On Desperate Ground: The Epic Story of Chosin Reservoir – The Greatest Battle of the Korean War - Hampton Sides. U.S. Marines caught in a trap set by Mao, surrounded and hugely outnumbered, faced with probable annihilation and temperatures plunging to 20 degrees below zero, fought through enemy forces as they marched to the sea. While detailing the follies of the American leaders, the historian author also provides an immediate, grunt's-eye view gained through interviews, letters and other documents that describe what ordinary men are capable of in the most extreme circumstances. Donated in memory of Young Ai's husband who grew up in North Korea.

The Shell Seekers – Rosamunde Pilcher. Penelope must decide what to do with her prized possession, her father's painting now worth a fortune, that symbolizes her life from bohemian childhood to wartime romance.

The Silent Wife – Kerry Fisher. Would you risk everything for the man you loved? Even if you knew he'd done something terrible?

The Sympathizer: A Novel – Viet Thanh Nguyen. Winner of the Pulitzer Prize for Fiction. The narrator, a communist double agent, is a half-French, half-Vietnamese army captain who arranges to come to America after the Fall of Saigon, and while building a new life with other Vietnamese refugees in Los Angeles is secretly reporting back to his communist superiors in Vietnam. A gripping espionage tale.
