NEW BOOKS – SEPTEMBER 2021

The Constitution Murders – Conover Hunt. At thirteen of America's iconic historic sites, intruders left pieces of a dismembered woman related to Nicholas II. A CIA agent and his former historian lover unravel the common denominator – the U.S. Constitution.

Dead of November: A Novel of Lake Superior – Craig Brockman. A suspenseful, lake-churning tale of a psychologist resolving grief over his wife who drowned, a power-hungry medicine man, and an ancient Ojibwe legend.

The Eagles Claw: a novel of the Battle of Midway. Jeff Shaara's well researched military historical fiction recounts with you-are-there immediacy one single battle from both sides that changed the outcome of the war.

The Great Halifax Explosion. John Bacon. A ticktock account, 2.9 kilotons of TNT vaporized, a 35-foot tsunami, 11,000 casualties, revolutionized pediatric medicine, etc., etc.

Into the Beautiful North – Luis Urrea. A young Mexican woman, noticing few men in her village, goes north to recruit seven men to repopulate her hometown and provide protection from bandidos who plan on taking it over.

The Journeys of David Toback. Carole Malkin. His coming of age and self-discovery in tsarist Russia culminating in his immigrating to the U.S.

The Mystery of Mrs. Christie (LP) – Marie Benedict. The reconstruction of one of the most notorious events in literary history: Agatha Christie's mysterious 11-day disappearance in 1926.

Overtime: Jim Harbaugh and the Michigan Wolverines at the Crossroads of College Football. John Bacon.

The Plot – Jean Korolitz. A once promising novelist teaching in a third-rate school steals a student's unpublished story following his death. Fame follows but an anonymous message - you are a thief – leads to terrifying discoveries.

The Switch: A Novel – Beth O'Leary. An 80-year-old grandmother living in a Yorkshire village and her overachiever granddaughter living in London decide to try a two-month swap which proves more difficult than either of them expected.

The Thursday Murder Club: A Novel (LP) – Richard Osman. Four unlikely friends meet weekly to discuss unsolved crimes but suddenly find themselves in the middle of their first live case. Can they catch the killer before it is too late?

The Time of our Lives: a conversation about America. Tom Brokaw.
